DIRECTIONS to SHOW GROUNDS

FROM:North & South via Interstate 295

Take Interstate-295 to Exit 65A - Sloan Avenue. Travel East on Sloan Avenue. After the second traffic light travel 0.7 miles to Paxson Ave. Turn left onto Paxson Avenue and proceed 0.9 mile to intersection of Hughes Drive and entrance to Mercer County Park.

FROM: South via US Highway #1

Cross Toll Bridge from Pennsylvania into New Jersey on US 1. Take first right past Quakerbridge Mall onto Quakerbridge Road. Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Hughes Drive. Proceed on Hughes Drive for 2 miles to entrance of Mercer County Park on the left.

FROM: South via Route 130 / 206

Follow Route 130 North to County Road 526 in Robbinsville. Turn left at traffic light at CR 526 and right at the next light (still CR 526). From this point travel 3 miles to County Road 535 (Edinburg Road). Turn left onto CR 535 and travel 0.2 miles to entrance of Mercer County Park on right.

FROM: North via US #1

Take US Highway 1 South of Princeton to County Road 533 (Quakerbridge Road).Make right into jug handle crossing over Route 1 onto CR 533. Travel 2.2 miles and turn left onto Hughes Drive. Proceed on Hughes Drive 2 miles to entrance of Mercer County Park on the left.

FROM: North via NJ Turnpike

Take Turnpike south to Exit 8 at Hightstown. Follow Route 33 West and turn right on County Road 571. Travel on CR 571 for 2.2 miles to County Road 535 and proceed 4 miles to entrance of Mercer County Park on the right.

Take Turnpike to Exit 7A.Follow west on Interstate-195 to Exit 5B.Travel north on Route 130 to first light (County Road 526). Turn left at light and right at next light (still CR 526). In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

CLOSING DATE for entries 6:00 PM, Wednesday April 15, 2020 at the Show Secretary's Office, make fees payable in US funds.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the NNJGSDC it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. Should acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify The Show Secretary at 551-206-9838 or mdlrn@aol.com

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable.

A recording fee of \$.50 and an event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording fee and an event Service fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rule, Chap. 11, Sect. 2)

These Recording Fees and event service fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES, Postdated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$30.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors will result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS** Make fees payable in US Funds.

Consult Judging Program For the time of Judging, Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the Judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES EXCEPT WHEN BEING JUDGED OR WHEN IN THE EXERCISE RING.

EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEAN CONDITIONS IN AND AROUND THEIR CRATES.

NNJGSDC WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog at the show or in transit to the show, or for the possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
