It must be understood that training the German Shepherd or any breed dog includes participation in "hands on" training, with attendance at orientation/education/discussions as well as practice at home.. These are integral aspects of obedience training, and is considered part of the trainees' application.

The fee for each obedience session is \$125 members, \$175 non-members. Payment <u>must</u> be made in full at the time of registration. Once you have taken a class, fees are non-refundable. Extenuating circumstances may be appealed to the Board of Governors for a pro-rated refund decision. The Board of Governors meets monthly.

There Are No make-up classes in a session. There are no credits given for missed classes. AGGRESIVE DOG POLICY:

Any dog that shows open aggression to another dog or person will be evaluated by the trainer prior to being accepted into a training class held by NNJGSDC. The trainer's evaluation will be the deciding factor in whether or not your dog will be accepted into a class.

<u>Aggressive Behavior</u> is described as follows:

- 1- Attacking another dog or person with intent to harm.
- 2- Biting or attempting to bite another dog or person at Any NNJGSDC class or function.
- 3- Snarling, Growling, Posturing.
- 4- Lunging with attempt to bite another dog or person.
- 5- Similar anti-social behavior where dog does not respond to the handler's efforts to control the situation.

Aggressive behavior cannot be tolerated in a class setting at any level. It is not fair to other students, or exhibitors to have to worry about the dog next to him attacking his own dog. It is also a liability to NNJGSDC to have dogs with this type of behavior at any NNJGSDC function.

Any and all aggressive behavior must be reported to the Obedience Coordinator and Training Hall Director, or whomever is in charge at a NNJGSDC function.

Any dog exhibiting aggressive behavior may, at the discretion of the trainer, be required to wear a muzzle in class.

I agree that my dog, may be removed from class in the event that the trainer and/or obedience coordinator determines, my dog / handler/owner creates a safety issue for any other dog / handler / owner or members of the public attending a training or public session.

I certify that the application information is correct, and accept full responsibility/liability for my dog. I further agree to hold harmless, the NNJGSD Club, its' officers, Board of Governors, trainer(s) and members for any incidents, damage, or injury to me and/or my dog as well as family or friends in attendance at a training session or public event.
